Curriculum Planning:

We do not have a planned topic each term. At James Lee we prefer "Planning in the Moment" and focus more on child initiated play. Please see the board in the entrance hall for more information or speak to your child's keyworker.

School Clothing:

An important part of the EYFS curriculum is for children to explore and learn through play. This means that children will be involved in many different and **often messy** sensory experiences both inside and outside the classroom. Bearing this in mind please ensure children are suitably dressed in clothes that can get messy.

Spare clothes bag:

Please remember to check your child's change of clothes bag **at the end of each day** to see if it needs topping up.

Note: Please put your child's name in their clothing.

Labelling your child's clothing

Could we ask all parents to label their children's clothing in particular coats, hats, scarfs and gloves. As you can appreciate it can be very difficult to keep track of 60 coats, 60 hats, 60 scarfs and 120 gloves!! Could you also ensure your child has spare socks in their bag.

Book Lending Library:



Please remember to choose a book with your child to take home and read together.

We also have an excellent selection of books in home languages.

School Lunch:

Please pay lunch money on Monday mornings for the week ahead. Lunch is £1.80 per day, £9 per week. If you wish to pay in advance for a term or half a term, please see Marie and she will advise you of the amount. Please make cheques payable to James Lee Nursery School. Please join us in welcoming Lisa Furlong to the team. Lisa will be helping us in the nursery for the Spring and Summer terms.

Breakfast club / Friday Crèche

Breakfast club runs from 8- 9am and cost £3.50 per session. Crèche is on Fridays from 12.30 – 2.45pm and costs £7.50 per session.

Priority goes to working/studying parents. If you book a place for the Crèche or Breakfast Club and need to cancel please give us 24 hours' notice or you will still be charged.

Scooters and Buggies:

Please place scooters in the scooter shed as neatly as possible as space is limited. Please write your child's name on their scooter. Please take buggies home with you as we have very limited space.
